

#### Specific Commands Do Not Require A Comprehensive List of What NOT To Do!

The Specific Command:

No Need to Specifically Prohibit:

Ex. Buy a loaf of wheat bread

lce cream, candy, soda, etc.

Make...an ark of gopherwood

Oak, teak, pine, cedar, etc.

Sing

Whistling, mechanical instruments, humming, etc.

Give on the first day of the week

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, etc.
