The Two-Part Question

For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?

- Emphasis: The Value of a Soul
- Lesson: This life is not our Primary Focus

The Divine Answer

- · What Does it Profit? It Does Not!
 - Riches Do Not Profit

Proverbs 11:4; Ecclesiastes 5:10

- Riches are Essentially Meaningless

Psalm 49:6-9

The Divine Answer What Day Doo Dive

- What Can One Give in Exchange? Nothing!
 - We Are Helpless

Romans 5:6

- All We Have is His, Anyway

 - A Ransom
